

ECZEMA REGIMEN

Please follow the regimen daily as directed below. All medications should be applied in the order they are written. Please read all directions carefully before you begin treatment.

- Cleanse skin with one of the following recommended cleansers. These can be found at your local drugstore:
 - Vanicream cleansing bar, Vanicream facial cleanser, Cetaphil Restoraderm body wash, Cetaphil cleanser, Dove unscented white bar soap.
 - o If you have eczema on the hands, avoid hand sanitizers and harsh hand soaps.
- Apply the topical medication ______ to all affected areas once/twice daily UNDER recommended moisturizer. The following recommended moisturizers can be found at your local drugstore:
 - Vanicream cream/lite lotion, Cerave cream/lotion, Cerave Anti-itch cream/lotion, Cetaphil Restoraderm Moisturizer, Cerave Therapeutic Hand Cream, Neutrogena Norwegian hand cream.
 - For additional moisturization, Robathol can be added to lukewarm bath, or applied to the skin while skin is damp after shower.
 - For hands, moisturize with recommended hand cream after ALL handwashing and anytime hands feel dry throughout the day. May also add a layer of Vaseline on top at night and wear cotton gloves.

ADDITIONAL TREATMENT

- For itching, the following has been prescribed for the patient to take at bedtime.
 ______ Take 1-2 hours before bedtime. Medication MAY cause drowsiness.
 - o Bleach Bath Therapy (see handout)
 - Wet Wraps (see handout)

THINGS TO AVOID:

- □ Long, hot showers/baths.
- □ Scented detergents (Wash clothes with a detergent that if Free & Clear).
- □ Scented body lotions, perfumes, and oils.
- Scratching the affected area. This can cause infection. We know it's hard, but please try to refrain and continue your treatment regimen.

Please contact the office if you experience any of the following: Fever, Chills, Swelling, or Yellow Crusting of an open wound.

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
